Re: Item 6.2 – WRSP PCL W-20 – Coffee Shack (File #PL20-0142) – Public Comments

The purpose of this memorandum is to include four public comment letters received subsequent to publication of the staff report for the above-referenced project (see Attachment 1). The email dated February 4, 2021 was submitted by Linda Rayle and states that the drive-through use would cause an increase in vehicle emissions and asks whether this was evaluated in the Initial Study/Mitigated Negative Declaration (IS/MND). Staff's response to Ms. Rayle's email is below. The three emails dated February 9, 2021 are addressed to the Planning Commission and are in support of the project.

The project emissions were evaluated in the IS/MND prepared for the project, under Section III (Air Quality) and Section VIII (Greenhouse Gases). Staff provided a copy of the IS/MND document to Ms. Rayle for review. The IS/MND is also included as Exhibit A to the Planning Commission staff report. As recommended by the Placer County Air Pollution Control District (PCAPCD), the California Emissions Estimator Model (CalEEMod) was used to quantify the project's construction and operational emissions (including mobile emissions) for criterial air pollutants (e.g., NO_x, ROG, and PM₁₀) and greenhouse gas emissions (CO₂e). CalEEMod was run using the "fast food with drive through" use category to accurately estimate the project's emissions. The CalEEMod model results are included as Attachment 2 to the IS/MND. The project's modeled total emissions are below the PCAPCD established thresholds of significance; therefore, the project will not result in a significant impact related to emissions, and no mitigation is required.
