

RESOLUTION NO. 21-116

ACCEPTING GRANT FUNDS FROM THE PLACER COUNTY AIR POLLUTION CONTROL DISTRICT, AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A GRANT AGREEMENT AND ALL RELATED DOCUMENTS, ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF ROSEVILLE

WHEREAS, in July of 2017, the California Assembly and Senate passed AB 617 directing the California Air Resources Board (CARB) to develop the Community Air Protection Program (CAPP); and

WHEREAS, in order to support AB 617 requirements, the Legislature has appropriated incentive funding, Community Air Protection (CAP) Incentives, to be administered by air districts in partnership with local communities; and

WHEREAS, the Placer County Air Pollution Control District (PCAPCD) released a call for projects and staff submitted Roseville’s Battery-Electric Bus (BEB) Charging Station for consideration; and

WHEREAS, PCAPCD has tentatively approved this project for funding in the amount of \$140,125.03 under this program, pending a Grant Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the Grant Agreement for the Battery-Electric Bus Charging Station, by and between PCAPCD and the City of Roseville, has been reviewed by the City Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Roseville that the City accepts the Community Air Protection Incentive grant funds and the City Manager, or his designee, is hereby authorized to execute the Grant Agreement and all related forms on behalf of the City of Roseville.
