ACCEPTING GRANT FUNDS AND COMMITTING TO SECURE ADDITIONAL FUNDS FOR AN OUTDOOR FITNESS COURT® AS PART OF THE 2021 CALIFORNIA PARK & RECREATION SOCIETY/NATIONAL FITNESS CAMPAIGN

WHEREAS, the City of Roseville submitted a Grant Application to the California Park & Recreation Society (CPRS)/National Fitness Campaign (NFC) for participation in the 2021 initiative to install and activate outdoor Fitness Courts® in 200 cities and schools across the country; and

WHEREAS, the City of Roseville will accept a \$25,000 grant award from CPRS/NFC and provide a local match in the amount of \$125,000 to promote and implement free access to the Fitness Court® and fee based outdoor fitness programs; and

WHEREAS, the City of Roseville will secure additional funding as needed through community sponsors; and

WHEREAS, the City of Roseville will commit to begin construction during the FY2021-22; and

WHEREAS, the City of Roseville believes the outdoor Fitness Court® is an important wellness ecosystem that supports healthier communities, commits to funding/fundraising to participate in CPRS/NFC's 2021 Campaign, and will earn local and national recognition as a leader in providing affordable health and wellness.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Roseville that the City accepts the 2021 California Park & Recreation Society/National Fitness Campaign grant funds.
