Background



- Census completed every 10 years
- Impacts funding for schools, infrastructure, housing, and more
- Shifts in population growth help inform redistricting process
- Helps define legislative district boundaries
- Assures compliance with Voting Rights Act



CA Elections Code



- Provides basic criteria and process
- Aligns with Voting Rights Act
- Must consider in this order:
 1. integrity of neighborhoods and communities of interest
 2. integrity of cities and census designated places
 3. natural and artificial barriers, including streets
 4. geographic compactness

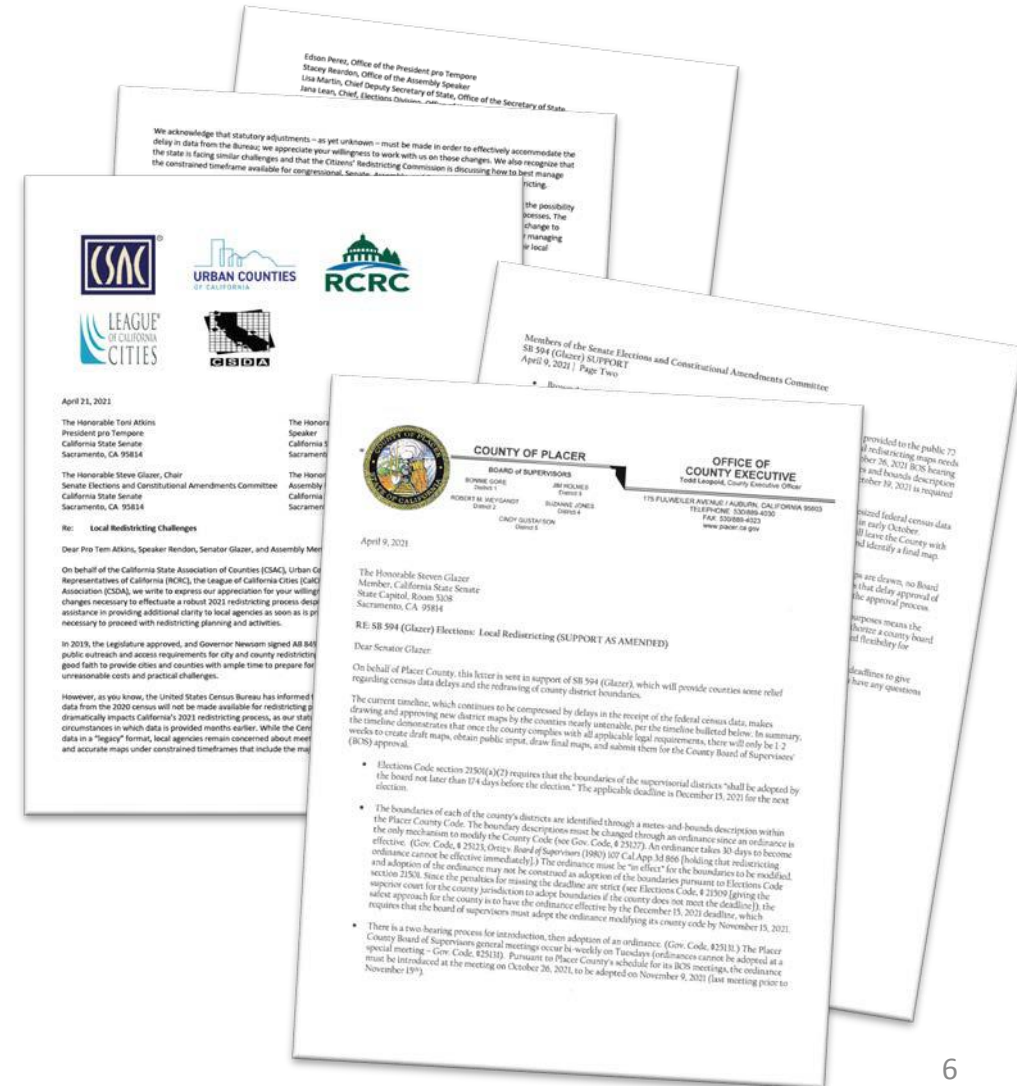

SB594 Legislation



- Placer County, CSAC, UCC, RCRC, CalCities, and CSDA sent letters outlining our concerns to the State of California
- SB 594 moving forward to address timeline issues

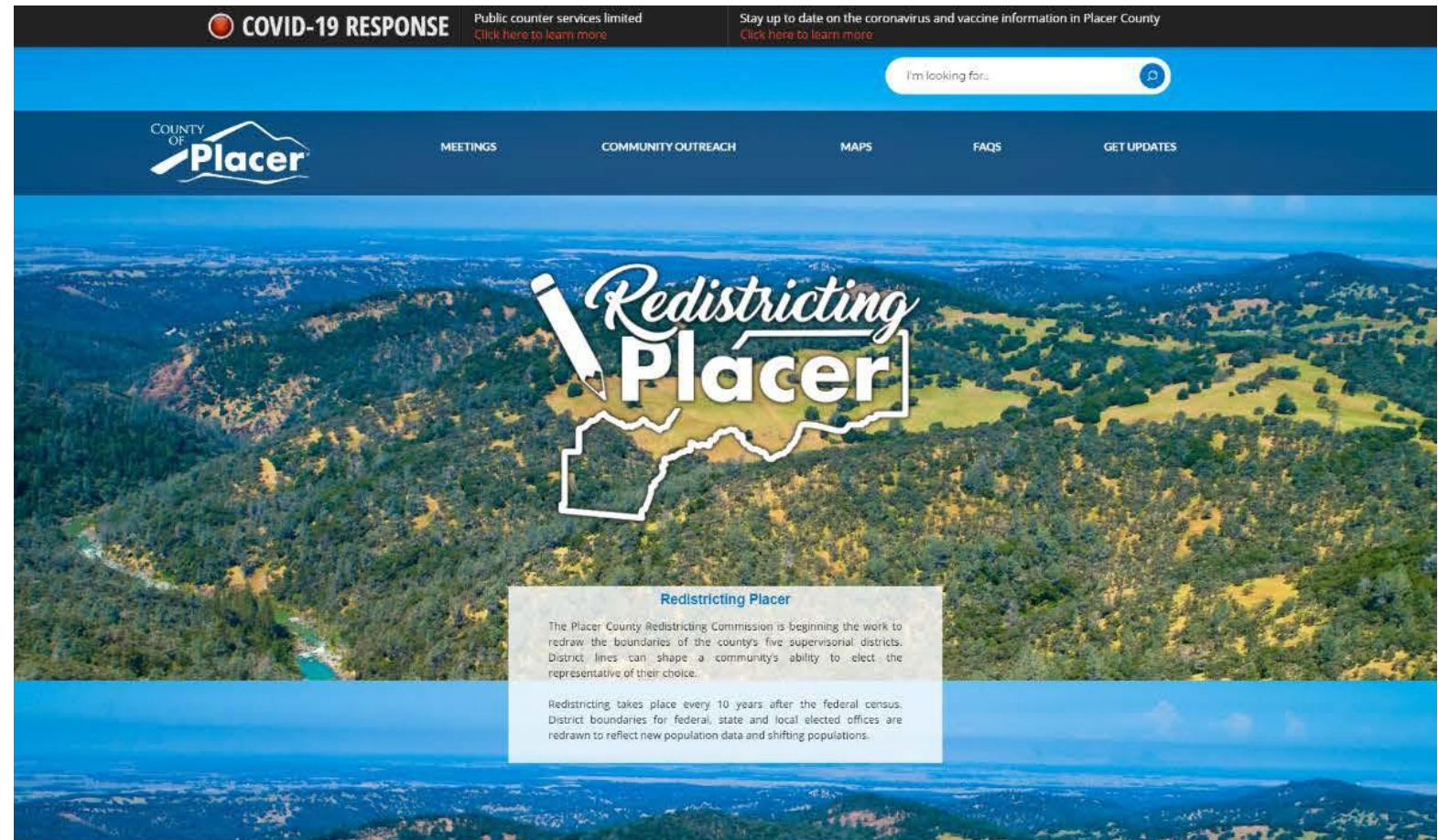
