

ORDINANCE NO. 6455

ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROSEVILLE AMENDING
ORDINANCE NO. 6306, THE SALARY ORDINANCE FOR SWORN EMPLOYEES
REPRESENTED BY THE ROSEVILLE POLICE OFFICERS' ASSOCIATION, AS
AMENDED BY APPENDIX "A" TO BE EFFECTIVE
FEBRUARY 12, 2022 AS AN URGENCY MEASURE

THE CITY OF ROSEVILLE ORDAINS:

SECTION 1. Title and Purpose.

Ordinance No. 6306, the Salary Ordinance for sworn employees represented by the Roseville Police Officers' Association, is hereby amended as shown on Appendix "A" for salary schedules A & B attached hereto, to reflect a general salary increase and Salary Schedule B compressed salary range for Police Sergeant.

SECTION 2. Salary Schedule Effective Date.

This Ordinance shall be effective February 12, 2022 as an urgency measure.

SECTION 3. Urgency Ordinance.

This ordinance is hereby declared to be an urgency measure, immediately necessary for the public peace, health and safety and shall take effect February 12, 2022. A statement of urgency is as follows:

It is necessary to amend the Salary Ordinance to comply with recently approved changes for the orderly and necessary continuance of operations of the City.

SECTION 4. Posting.

The City Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to post a true copy of the foregoing ordinance in each of three (3) conspicuous locations in the City and she shall immediately after such posting enter in the Ordinance Book under the record of the ordinance a certificate under her hand stating the time and place of said publication by posting.
