

RESOLUTION NO. 22-035

APPROVING THE CITY NEIGHBORHOOD IDENTIFICATION
SIGN POLICY AND PROGRAM

WHEREAS, since the inception of neighborhood associations (“NA”) in Roseville, the NA’s and the Roseville Coalition of Neighborhood Associations (“RCONA”) have been a valuable partner in creating an engaged and involved community; and

WHEREAS, the City, after an inquiry from and suggestive input by RCONA on appropriate and cost-effective ways to recognize and identify its active NA's, developed this City Neighborhood Identification Sign Policy and Program in order to assist the community in identifying these community locations; and

WHEREAS, the City Neighborhood Identification Sign Policy and Program, has been reviewed by City Council.

WHEREAS, in adopting this Neighborhood Identification Sign Policy and Program, the City Council declares that the use of any City of Roseville lights, signs, poles, posts, facilities, or property owned or maintained by the City of Roseville for the Neighborhood Identification Sign Policy and Program is not intended to serve, open, or create forums for free expression by the public, but rather are maintained as nonpublic forums for the display of signs outlined in the City Neighborhood Identification Sign Policy and Program, as an expression of the City Council’s, and its designee(s), including, but not limited to the City Manager, official speech and expressions (government speech); and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Roseville that the City Neighborhood Identification Sign Policy and Program is hereby approved.
