WHEREAS, the City Council approved the Roseville Greenhouse Gas Cap-and-Trade Program in August 2012 and updated said program in February 2013; and

WHEREAS, this program defines how Roseville Electric will use the emission allowances it receives from the State each year; and

WHEREAS, the City's 2023 allocation of Greenhouse Cap-and-Trade Program allowances is 334,821; and

WHEREAS, staff recommends all 334,821 vintage 2023 directly allocated allowances be directed to Roseville's compliance account.
