LETTER IN SUPPORT FOR THE GATHERING INN'S APPLICATION TO THE  
CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH CARE SERVICES AND CALIFORNIA  
DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL SERVICES COMMUNITY CARE EXPANSION PROGRAM

WHEREAS, on June 3, 2022, the California Department of Health Care Services and Department of Social Services released a joint Request for Applications (RFA) for \$570 million in infrastructure funding under the Community Care Expansion program for acquisition, construction, and rehabilitation to preserve and expand adult and senior care facilities serving Supplemental Security Income/State Supplementary Payment and Cash Assistance Program for Immigrants applicants and recipients, including those who are experiencing or at risk of homelessness; and

WHEREAS, contingent on site control and funding, The Gathering Inn (TGI) is proposing a 30-bed medical respite center at 300 Elefa Street; and

WHEREAS, TGI is pursuing an application for funding under this RFA to support the expansion of its medical respite center in Roseville; and

WHEREAS, the proposed center will be an expansion of TGI's current 10-bed medical respite center located in Auburn.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Roseville that City Staff is directed to prepare a Letter of Support for The Gathering Inn's application to the California Department of Health Care Services and California Department of Social Services Community Care Expansion program for California Health and Human Services Agency infrastructure funding and said Letter of Support may be executed by the Mayor, or her designee, on behalf of the Council of the City of Roseville.
