

RESOLUTION NO. 22-472

RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROSEVILLE CANVASSING VOTES OF THE NOVEMBER 8, 2022 GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION AND DECLARING THE RESULTS THEREOF PER PLACER COUNTY OFFICIAL ELECTION RESULTS

WHEREAS, a General Municipal Election was held on Tuesday, November 8, 2022, in accordance with the law for the purpose of electing two (2) councilmembers for four (4) year terms of office, and proposing the enactment of Measure C, an amendment to the City of Roseville Transient Occupancy Tax (TOT) rate, from 6% to 10%; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Roseville City Council to canvass the return of said election votes and to declare the results; and

1. That a General Municipal Election was held on Tuesday, November 8, 2022;
2. That the following candidates were voted on and elected as City Councilmembers in said election, for four (4) year terms:

Pauline Roccucci (District 2); and Krista Bernasconi (District 4)

3. That the final tabulations of the votes cast is as follows:

4. That pursuant to Section 2.03 of the Charter, Krista Bernasconi is hereby declared to be the Vice-Mayor. The Vice-Mayor's term of office shall commence upon the assumption of office and shall continue until the next election or assumption of office of a successor. Upon the conclusion of the term of office as Vice-Mayor, Krista Bernasconi shall be seated as Mayor. The Mayor's term of office shall commence upon the assumption of office and continue until the assumption of a successor;

5. That the City Clerk or her designee is hereby directed to deliver to Pauline Roccucci (District 2) and Krista Bernasconi (District 4) a certificate of election and to administer to said persons the oath of office as prescribed in the Constitution of the State of California. That the

term of office and administration of the Oath of Office shall occur and commence immediately following the approval of this resolution, here on Wednesday, December 21, 2022;

6. That the following ballot measure is hereby declared to have passed, which does not limit the use of the tax revenues and is therefore enacted as a general tax:

Measure C – City of Roseville, Hotel and Lodging Tax Measure

“YES” Votes 41,546 72.33%

“NO” Votes 15,891 27.67%

The following results for the 53 precincts in the City of Roseville for Measure C indicate that the measure was approved by the voters and is hereby declared as having passed:

7. That the City Clerk is hereby directed to enter the adoption of this Resolution in the minutes of the City Council as a statement of the results of the General Municipal Election held on November 8, 2022.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Roseville that the City Council hereby ratifies and approves the election results as presented.
