Project Title: Roseville Energy Park and Roseville Peaking Plant Continuous Emissions Monitoring Equipment Rehabilitation and Upgrades

Project Location(s): 5120 Phillip Road, Roseville, CA 95747. Assessor's Parcel Numbers 017-101-020-000 and 017-101-021-000.

Project Description: Roseville Electric staff seeks a sole source purchase order to Teledyne Monitoring Labs for an upgrade to the continuous emissions monitoring (CEMS) equipment at the Roseville Energy Park (REP) and Roseville Peaking Plant (RPEAK). The existing equipment at both facilities is no longer supported by the equipment manufacturer and has reached end of life. The proposed replacement equipment is for like-in-kind modernized replacements of the existing REP CEMS programmable logic controls (PLCs). Additionally, the quote contains the parts necessary to replace the existing RPEAK PLCs with the same equipment which will be used at the REP. This will standardize PLC equipment between the two plants reducing training requirements, required parts inventories, etc. The project would not result in an expansion of use.

Public Agency Approving Project: Roseville City Council

Agency/Individual Carrying Out Project: Roseville Electric Utility

Reason why this Project is Exempt: The project qualifies for a Class 1 Categorical Exemption as described in Section 15301 of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) guidelines which states:

"Class 1 consists of the...repair, maintenance,...or minor alteration of existing public or private structures, facilities, mechanical equipment, or topographical features, involving negligible or no expansion of existing or former use... Examples include, but are not limited to: (a) Interior or exterior alterations involving such things as interior partitions, plumbing, and electrical conveyances; [and] (b) Existing facilities of both investor and publicly owned utilities used to provide electrical power, natural gas, sewerage, or other public utility services..."

The project consists of replacing and repairing existing CEMS equipment at the REP and RPEAK because the existing equipment is no longer supported by the manufacturer and has reached end of life. The project would not result in expansion of use. Consequently, the Class 1 Categorical Exemption applies.
