WHEREAS, CITY and CONSULTANT previously entered into an Agreement dated August 21, 2013, amended on July 16, 2014 and amended July 15, 2015 ("Agreement") regarding engineering, surveying and landscape architectural services for the Harry Crabb Park Phase II Project ("Project"); and

WHEREAS, CITY desires to amend the Agreement to include additional services as described in CONSULTANT's proposal dated January 22, 2019, which is attached hereto as as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein by reference; and

WHEREAS, CONSULTANT is willing and able to provide such additional services; and

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties agree as follows:

 CONSULTANT shall provide additional services as described in Exhibit "A" of this Third Amendment to Agreement.

Paragraph 2 of the Agreement is amended by adding an additional paragraph to 2. read as follows: "CITY shall pay one hundred eight thousand, three hundred sixty dollars (\$108,360.00), in consideration of the additional services as set forth in Exhibit "A" to the Third Amendment to Agreement. This brings the total not to exceed contract amount to two hundred seventy-eight thousand, nine hundred seventy-seven dollars (\$278,977.00)." All other provisions of the Agreement shall remain unchanged and in full force 3. and effect. Our scope of work, based on previous emails and our familiarity with the project are, follows.

I. Project Description

Prepare the revised park improvement plans that merges the former phases 2a and 2b back together as well as implement various value engineering efforts, and site plan changes in the tennis and basketball court areas.

II. Scope of Work

Siegfried Engineering, Inc. (Siegfried) will provide civil engineering, landscape architecture, and athletic facility design services to the City of Roseville (Client) for the 2019 Crabb Park (Project) in Roseville, California including the following services:

Task 1 – Construction Document Revisions and Agency Review

Siegfried will prepare the revised improvement plans, specifications, and estimates based upon the December 2018 feasibility estimate plans prepared by Siegfried. The following primary tasks are anticipated:

- 9. Prepare, QA/QC, and submit the 100% plans, specifications, and cost estimate
- 10. Address 100% plan review comments and respond in written format
- 11. Prepare, QA/QC, and submit the Final plans, specifications, and cost estimate



Task 2 - Bidding and Construction Assistance (Optional)

Perform the following services or other services as directed by the city of Roseville on an hourly to a maximum basis. Additional services may be performed upon written approval by the city per the attached rate sheet.

- 1. Assist the Client with plan interpretation during call for bids and prepare minor addenda as necessary to clarify plan intent.
- 2. Attend the preconstruction meeting.
- 3. Assist contractor with plan interpretation during construction.
- 4. Prepare minor addendums to clarify plan intent.
- 5. Review site development submittals and shop drawings related to the design scope of work.
- 6. Provide up to three (3) site visits during construction excluding the final punch list walk.
- 7. Provide site review at project completion to aid Client in developing a final site punch list.
- 8. At the time of plant material delivery but prior to the material being installed review the plant material for variety, quality, and health. Any material deemed questionable will be identified for the Client. Said review does not warranty or guarantee the remaining material, it is still the site contractor's responsibility to maintain and guarantee their work under the terms of the project documents.

It is understood that exclusions to the above scope of services shall be any service not specifically described above. The following items <u>are not</u> included in the scope:

- a. Geotechnical and Environmental Engineering,

- c. Structural Observation per the CBC (none anticipated),
- d. Potholing to determine location and/or elevation of underground utilities,
- e. Permit applications and fees,
- f. Construction staking,
- g. QSD/QSP Services
