FIRST AMENDMENT

to the

AMERICAN RIVER BASIN STUDY

MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

By and Between

U.S. Department of the Interior,

Bureau of Reclamation, Mid-Pacific Region

and

Placer County Water Agency

El Dorado County Water Agency

A Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) was made and entered into by and between the parties named above to work collaboratively to perform the American River Basin Study (ARBS) as part of Reclamation's WaterSMART Program. Pursuant to Article 4. B, the parties to this MOA agree to the following amendments.

- 1. WHEREAS, the budget for Reclamation's cost share of \$830,000 as identified in Section 2.C. of the MOA is increased by \$369,600 for a new total cost share of \$1,199,600, since the MOA identifies the available total cost share for the four non-Federal Partners as \$1,856,000, no increase in the Partner's cost share is necessary. Therefore Reclamation's cost share is amended by deleting "\$830,000" where it occurs and replacing it with "\$1,199,600".
- 2. Other Terms Remain the Same.

Other than the amendment to increase the cost share budget identified in Section 2.C., all other terms and conditions of the MOA shall remain the same.

3. Counterparts.

This First Amendment to the MOA can be executed in counterparts, each of which shall be deemed to be an original, but all of which together shall constitute one and the same instrument.

4. Effective Date.

This First Amendment to the MOA for the American River Basin Study will become effective upon full execution of this First Amendment by the Bureau of Reclamation, Placer County Water Agency, El Dorado County Water Agency, Regional Water Authority, City of Sacramento, City of Roseville, and City of Folsom.

5. Signatures and Authorities.
