

RESOLUTION NO. 20-128

APPROVING AN ELECTRIC DISTRIBUTION UTILITY JOINDER TO THE CLEAN FUEL REWARD GOVERNANCE AGREEMENT, BY AND BETWEEN PACIFIC GAS & ELECTRIC, SAN DIEGO GAS & ELECTRIC COMPANY, SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA EDISON COMPANY, LOS ANGELES DEPARTMENT OF WATER & POWER AND SACRAMENTO MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT AND THE CITY OF ROSEVILLE, AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE IT ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF ROSEVILLE

WHEREAS, since early 2017, Roseville Electric Utility has been participating in California Air Resources Board (CARB) Low Carbon Fuel Standard (LCFS) program; and

WHEREAS, to enhance the LCFS program, CARB, in collaboration with electric utilities throughout the state, developed a new statewide point-of-purchase rebate for electric vehicles called the Clean Fuel Reward (CFR) program; and

WHEREAS, electric utilities participating in the LCFS program are required to enter into the CFR Governance Agreement; and

WHEREAS, executing the agreement allows Roseville Electric Utility to continue to participate in the LCFS program and generate proceeds to support electric vehicle programs in the community; and

WHEREAS, the Electric Distribution Utility Joinder to the Clean Fuel Reward Governance Agreement, by and between Pacific Gas & Electric, San Diego Gas & Electric Company, Southern California Edison Company, Los Angeles Department of Water & Power and Sacramento Municipal Utility District and the City Of Roseville, has been reviewed by City Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Roseville that said Electric Distribution Utility Joinder to the Clean Fuel Reward Governance Agreement is hereby approved and the City Manager is authorized to execute it on behalf of the City of Roseville.
