SUBMITTING A CERTAIN MEASURE TO THE QUALIFIED VOTERS AT THE GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON NOVEMBER 3, 2020

WHEREAS, the City Council has received and reviewed the report of the Charter Review Commission of the City of Roseville; and

WHEREAS, the City Council now desires to submit the recommendations of the Charter Review Commission to the voters of the City of Roseville for approval.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Roseville as follows:

- 1. That the proposed amendment to the charter of the City of Roseville recommended by the Charter Review Commission is hereby approved by the City Council.
- 2. The City Council hereby submits the proposed charter amendments to the qualified voters of the City of Roseville for consideration at the General Municipal Election to held on Tuesday, November 3, 2020. The proposed amendment is as follows:
- MEASURE Shall Section 2.02 of the City Charter be amended to specify that a partial term on the Council of less than 2 years does not count as a term for purposes of term limits but that a combination of an appointment followed by an election, which together exceeds 2 years, to a vacant Council seat shall count as a term for purposes of term limits?
 - 3. Attachment of the text of the measure and the proposed textual changes to the City Charter are hereby incorporation by reference.
