

RESOLUTION NO. 20-252

**SUBMITTING A CERTAIN MEASURE TO THE QUALIFIED VOTERS AT THE
GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON NOVEMBER 3, 2020**

WHEREAS, the City Council has received and reviewed the report of the Charter Review Commission of the City of Roseville; and

WHEREAS, the City Council now desires to submit the recommendations of the Charter Review Commission to the voters of the City of Roseville for approval.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Roseville as follows:

1. That the proposed amendment to the charter of the City of Roseville recommended by the Charter Review Commission is hereby approved by the City Council.
2. The City Council hereby submits the proposed charter amendments to the qualified voters of the City of Roseville for consideration at the General Municipal Election to be held on Tuesday, November 3, 2020. The proposed amendment is as follows:

MEASURE **Shall Section 4.02 of the City Charter be amended to: (1) allow special meetings of the Council to also be called by the City manager or City attorney consistent with the City's existing practices; (2) require 72 hours' notice for special meetings if feasible instead of 24 hours' notice; and (3) allow notice of special meetings to be served on councilmembers electronically?**

3. Attachment of the text of the measure and the proposed textual changes to the City Charter are hereby incorporation by reference.
