RESOLUTION NO. 20-255

SUBMITTING A CERTAIN MEASURE TO THE QUALIFIED VOTERS AT THE **GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON NOVEMBER 3, 2020**

WHEREAS, the City Council has received and reviewed the report of the Charter Review Commission of the City of Roseville; and

WHEREAS, the City Council now desires to submit the recommendations of the Charter Review Commission to the voters of the City of Roseville for approval.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Roseville as follows:

- 1. That the proposed amendment to the charter of the City of Roseville recommended by the Charter Review Commission is hereby approved by the City Council.
- 2. The City Council hereby submits the proposed charter amendments to the qualified voters of the City of Roseville for consideration at the General Municipal Election to held on Tuesday, November 3, 2020. The proposed amendment is as follows:

MEASURE Shall provisions of Article 10 of the City Charter regarding municipally-owned utilities be amended as follows:

- (1) Shall Section 10.01 of the City Charter be amended to prohibit the City from providing retail potable water to new service areas outside the City limits after January 1, 2021?
- (2) Shall Section 10.02 of the City Charter be amended to remove from the Council the authority to delegate to the City manager the ability to establish nonresidential electric rates and to clarify that the Council may establish such rates by ordinance?
- 3. Attachment of the text of the measure and the proposed textual changes to the City Charter are hereby incorporation by reference.
