RESOLUTION NO. 22-329

ADOPTING THE SUBSEQUENT INITIAL STUDY/MITIGATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION AND APPROVING THE MITIGATION MONITORING AND REPORTING PROGRAM FOR THE ROSEVILLE REGIONAL SPORTS COMPLEX PROJECT

WHEREAS, a 25 acre Regional Sports Complex was proposed at 2600 Westbrook Drive in West Roseville; and

WHEREAS, the City entered into a Purchase and Sale Agreement to add an additional 20 acres immediately to the south of the project site; and

WHEREAS, once the purchase of the 20 acres is complete, the complex site will total approximately 51 acres supporting ten fields, and makes the complex a more attractive site for statewide and regional events; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), a Subsequent Initial Study/Mitigated Negative Declaration (IS/MND) was prepared for the proposed project; and

WHEREAS, the Subsequent Initial Study/Mitigated Negative Declaration (IS/MND) was made available for a 30 day public review and comment period from July 12, 2022 through August 10, 2022; and

WHEREAS, consistent with CEQA Guidelines Section 15097, a Mitigation Monitoring and Reporting Plan (MMRP) has been prepared to assist with the tracking and implementation of required mitigation measures; and

WHEREAS, the Subsequent Initial Study conclusion is that with implementation of all mitigation measures identified in the IS/MND and MMRP, all potential impacts would be reduced to less than significant and an MND is proposed to satisfy CEQA requirements; and

WHEREAS, staff recommends adoption of the IS/MND and approval of the MMRP to satisfy the project's CEQA requirements.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Roseville that it finds on the basis of the Subsequent Initial Study/Mitigated Negative Declaration, and the whole record, including public comments and other documents, that if the Roseville Regional Sports Complex Project is conditioned with mitigation measures as proposed, there is no substantial evidence that the Project will have a significant effect on the environment; the Mitigated Negative Declaration reflects the independent judgment and analysis of the City of Roseville, and the Mitigated Negative Declaration for the Project is hereby adopted.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mitigation Monitoring and Reporting Program for the Roseville Regional Sports Complex Project is hereby approved.
